

Closure of Willoby Street, Beaufort, for hedge trimming

The hedge in Memorial Park, Beaufort, will be trimmed on July 8 and 9, weather permitting. Willoby Street between Livingstone and Havelock streets will be closed between 8am and 5pm on those dates to allow the work to take place. Detours will be in place.

Roadworks - Spring Flat Road, Crowlands

Work will start soon to build two major culverts with floodway decks on Spring Flat Road, Crowlands.
