ROADWORKS

Linton Carngham Road

Pavement re-construction works have begun on Linton Carngham Road, Snake Valley, between the Shire boundary and Laurence Drive.

Eurambeen Raglan Rd, Raglan

Council has started the reconstruction of 1.4km of Eurambeen Raglan Rd, Raglan between the Western Highway and Back Raglan Rd. Pavement works have started.

Drainage Works Astbury Street Avoca

Drainage works to improve the table drain along Astbury Street, to the west of Homebush Road are happening. Traffic management will be in place but only minor interruption to traffic is likely.

Culvert replacement Linton-Carngham Road Snake Valley

A culvert is planned to be replaced on the Linton Carngham Road just to the north of Laurence Drive, Snake Valley. Works are scheduled for late January through to early February. Traffic management will be in place and there is likely to be some disruption to traffic for the duration of the works.

Floodway and road reconstruction Lower Wimmera Road, Glenlogie

Works are scheduled from late January through February. Traffic management will be in place and there is likely to be some disruption to traffic for the duration of the works. A road closure will be in place for several days while construction of the floodway is undertaken.

Western Highway, Trawalla resurfacing works

The Department of Transport and Planning is delivering works on approximately 1.3km of the Western Highway in Trawalla, between Spring Hill Creek and Trawalla Road (Ararat bound).

These rehabilitation works will restore the condition of the road surface. Works teams will be on site during the day between 7am and 6 pm from Monday 6 January to March. Please note these dates and times are subject to change due to weather conditions.

During the works, you may notice single lane closures with traffic management in place, and reduced speed limits.
